

## **Harrow Inn Circular Walk 1**

**Distance Option 1 3.03 miles, Option 2 3.37miles**

**From the Harrow Inn walk left along Harrow Road.**

**At the junction turn left into Chevening Lane.**

**After the houses there is a footpath to the right, this is the North downs Way.**

**Follow the path, which is well signposted until you reach Sundridge Lane.**

*Next to one of the gates along this path there is another gate with a viewing area, this is called the Keyhole and you can see Chevening House through it.*

**Cross Sundridge Lane and continue the North Downs Way, which goes left and right round the field.**

**You will see a path to the right towards and then past the trees in the middle of the field, follow this and you will reach Main Road.**

*These trees are known as The Knockholt Beeches and are the highest point of the village which is the highest village in Kent.*

**Turn right on to Main Road and continue until you reach Blueberry Lane on the left.**

*You will pass St Katharine's Church on the left, a church has stood here since 1281.*

**At this point you can either continue along Main Road (Option 1) and bear right onto Harrow Road and back to the Harrow Inn OR turn left into Blueberry Lane**

*Blueberry Lane looks very much the same as it did 100 years ago*

**At the crossroads turn right into Pound Lane (Option 2), at the end of which you cross Main Road towards Harrow Road, turn left along Harrow Road and back to the Harrow Inn.**
