

Harrow Inn Circular Walk 2 distance 4.17 miles

From the Harrow Inn walk right along Old London Road until you reach the bend in the road, take the footpath in front of you and turn right along the fence. Follow the fencing until you see the footpath sign on the right, take this path which crosses the road to a kissing gate.

Take the footpath around the field until you reach another gate on the right, this is the North Downs Way.

Follow this path and just before the metal gate turn left and then follow the path down through the woods and over the stile

Follow the path downhill to the right far corner of the field where there is a kissing gate.

Follow the footpath and take the stile on the right, follow this path and cross the track, the path will now curve right up the hill to a kissing gate.

Along this path to your left you will see Chevening House.

Eventually the path will enter woodland and you reach a junction, turn left and then right onto Sundridge Lane.

Walk up Sundridge Lane until you reach a metal gate with a kissing gate next to it on the right. This is the North Downs Way, follow this until you reach Chevening Lane.

Next to one of the gates along this path there is another gate with a viewing area, this is called the Keyhole and you can get another view of Chevening House through it.

Turn left and at junction turn right into Harrow Road and follow it back to the Harrow Inn.
